

**Extract from Haryana Govt. Gaz June 29, 1971 (ASAR, 8, 1893 SAKA)**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING DEPARTMENT  
The 17<sup>th</sup> December, 1970**

No. 8028 VDP-70/6784- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 (b) of the Punjab Scheduled Road and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963, the Governor of Haryana pleased to declare the area around Shahabad as specified in the Schedule given below and the Drg. No. STP (H)/1533/70 dated 16<sup>th</sup> October, 1970 appended hereto to be a controlled area for the purposes the said Act:-

**SCHEDULE**

Area around Shahabad is as under:-

West:- Starting from point 'A' at the inter-section of Ambala-Delhi Railway line and the northern boundary of village Rattangarh; towards the north along the eastern boundary of Shahabad; then along the municipal boundary upto 'C' and then again along the municipal boundary towards north upto point 'D'.

North:-From point 'D' further along the municipal boundary towards east up to a point 'E' on the bund at a distance of 13/4 kilometer from the railway line.

East:- From point 'E' paralalled to the railway line at a distance of 13/4 kilometre upto the point 'F' on the northern boundary of village Rattangarh.

South:-From point 'F' towards west along the northern boundary of village Rattangarh upto the starting point 'A'.
