No. - CCP(NCR)/KKR-CA-2/1620.-In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963 (Act 41 of 1961), the Governor of Haryana hereby declares the area within a distance of eight kilometers around the municipal town of Shahabad as specified in the schedule given below and shown in the plan appended hereto, to be a controlled area for the purpose of the said Act namely:-

SCHEDULE

Schedule of Boundaries of the Additional Controlled Area around Municipal Town of Shahabad, District Kurukshetra to be read with drawing no. DTP (KK)-688/1997 dated 24th October, 1997.

SCHEDULE OF BOUNDARIES OF ADDITIONAL CONTROLLED AREA

North: Starting from point A, i.e. tri-junction point of village Nagla (H.B. No. 255), village Zainpura (H.B. No. 231) and village Patt- Shahzadpur (H.B. No. 254) moving towards north, along the western boundary of village Zainpur thence moving south ward along the revenue boundary of village Zainpur (H.B. No. 231) crossing western side of village Phirni of Zainpur. Thence moving south ward along the western side of village Phirni of Zainpur, thence along the southern side of village Phirni moving in east direction and thence moving along the eastern side of Phirni in north direction which meets the southern side of revenue rasta, thence moving along the southern side of revenue rasta which is moving in north-east side, crossing the Delhi-Ambala Railway line and joining National Highway No. 1. Thence it moves along the northern side of Killa No. 440, 442, 443, 444 of village Zainpur upto the revenue boundary of village Zainpur. Thence moving in south-east direction along the revenue boundary of village Zainpur upto tri-junction point of revenue boundaries of village Zainpur (H.B. No. 231), Patti-Kankara (H.B. No. 232) and Dau-Majra (H.B. No. 230). Thence moving along the revenue boundary of village Patti-Kankara in south-east direction (Crossing River Markanda) and along the northern side of revenue boundary of village Rawa (H.B. No. 239) upto the point B i.e. tri-junction point of boundary of village Padlu (H.B. No. 237) village Rawa (H.B. No. 239) and village Salimpur (H.B. No. 121).

East: Thence moving from point B towards south along the eastern revenue boundary of village Jogi-Majra (H.B. No. 120) and village Jandheri (H.B. No. 240) up to point which is the tri-junction of village Jandheri, village Yari (H.B. No. 119) and village Deeg (H.B. No. 118).

South: Thence moving from point C towards west along the southern revenue boundaries of village Jandheri (H.B. No. 240), village Chhapra (H.B. No. 241), village Kishangarh (H.B. No. 248), village Chack Kharjee-Kishangarh, village Rattangarh (H.B. No. 249), village Dharamgarh (H.B. No. 247), western boundary of village Rattangarh, southern boundary of village Madanpur (H.B. No. 250) up to point D which is the tri-junction point of village Madanpur, village Mohanpur (H.B. No. 267) and village Kalsana (H.B. No. 266).

West: Thence from point moving towards north along western revenue boundaries of village Madanpur (H.B. No. 250), village Patt-Jhambra (H.B. No. 253), village Gumti (H.B. No. 252) and village Patti Shahzadpur (H.B. No. 254) up to point A which is the point of start.
