No. CCP(NCR)/ KKR/CA-ALNG NH-1/2009/3339 :- Whereas in the opinion of the Government the area specified in the Scheduled given below and shown in the plan appended hereto has the potential for building activities and haphazard development;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Area Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963 (Punjab Act 41 of 1963), the Governor of Haryana hereby declares the said area to be a controlled area for the purposes of the said Act, namely:-

Schedule

Schedule of boundaries of the controlled area along the National Highway Number 1 (Shershah Suri Marg) in between additional controlled area of Kurukshetra and Shahabad, District Kuruskhtra should be read with Drawing No. DTP (KKR) 946/09, dated 16th April, 2009.

Pocket 1

North: Starting from point 'A' i.e. North West corner of rectangle number 1 of village Chhorpur (Hadbast number 218). Thence moving towards east and south-east along the southern Distirct Boundary of district Ambala upto point 'B' i.e. tri-junction point of revenue boundaries of village Mohra (Hadbast number 188), village Khanpur (Hadbast No. 190) and village Mohri (Hadbast No. 217).

East: Thence moving from point 'B' towards south and south-west along the western district boundary of District Ambala upto the point 'C' i.e. the south-west corner of rectangle number 60 of village Landi (Hadbast No. 229)

South: Thence moving from point 'C' towards west along the already decarled controlled area boundary of Kurukshetra published in Haryana Government Gazettee vide notification no. CCP (NCR) KKR-CA-2/1620, dated 18th September, 1998 upt point 'D' i.e. south-east corner of rectangle no. 45 of village Mahi-ul-Dinpur (Hadbast No. 224).

West: Thence moving from point 'D' towards north-west and north along the western revenue boundaries of village Mahi-ul-Dinpur (Hadbast No. 224) , village Halderi (Hadbast No. 220) village Samalkhi (Hadbast No. 219) and village Chhorpur (Hadbast No. 218) upto point 'A' i.e. the point of start.
