**Notification**

**The 22nd September, 1976**

No. 3870-2TCP-76/31809- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (i) of Section 4 of the Punjab Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to declare the area around Municipal Town of Sirsa, as specified in the schedule given below and shown in the plan appended hereto, to be a controlled area for the purposes of the said Act, namely:

**ANNEXURE**

**SCHEDULE OF BOUNDARIES OF CONTROLLED AREA AROUND SIRSA**

(To be read along with Drawing No DTP (H) 1284/76 dated 11<sup>th</sup> March, 1976, Map attached)

North - Starting from point 'A' i.e. the point where revenue boundary of village Kelnia and Ahmadpur meet thence proceeding towards East along the Northern boundary of the revenue estates of village Ahmadpur and Mirpur upto the point 'B', then proceeding towards South along the Eastern boundaries of revenue estate of village Mirpur upto the point 'C' then further proceeding towards East along the Northern boundary or revenue estate of village Mirpur upto the point 'D' where it meets the Western boundary of revenue estate of village Nejadela Kalan then proceeding along the Northern boundary of revenue estates of village Nejadela Kalan towards East upto point 'E' i.e. the trijunction of the revenue estate boundary of villages Handikhera, Kasankhera and Nejadela Kalan.

East-Starting from point 'E' then proceeding towards South along the Eastern boundary of the revenue Estates of villages Handikhera and Vaidwala upto the point 'E' where it meets the revenue boundary of village Bajekan, thence proceeding further South along the revenue boundary of village Bajekan upto point 'G'; which is at a distance of 610 meters (2,000 ft) from boundary of Sirsa-Hisar Road, thence towards East parallel to the Sirsa-Hisar Road, upto point 'H' where it meets the Southern revenue boundary of village Sikandarpur, thence towards South West along the revenue boundary of village Moriwala upto the point 'I' where it meets the revenue boundary of village Bajekan ; thence towards North along the revenue boundary of village Bajekan upto the Railway boundary ; thence towards West along the Railway boundary upto the point 'J' where it meets the revenue boundary of village Vaidwala; thence along the Eastern revenue boundary of village Vaidwala & Village Kanangpur and Village Shahpur Begu upto the point 'K' where it meets the revenue boundary of village Nejaiakhera.

South-Starting from point 'K' then proceeding along the Southern revenue boundary of village Shahpur Begu, Village Natar and village Ram Nagaria upto 'L' where it meets the boundary of village Bhamboor.

West: Starting from point 'L' then proceeding towards North along the Western Revenue boundary of village Ram Nagaria and village Shamshabad Badand Village Ahmadpur upto point 'A' i.e the point of starting.

Controlled Area around the Municipal limits of Sirsa Town is enclosed as "A B C D E F G H I J K L"

The controlled area excludes the Municipal Area of Sirsa Town and abatehs of villages.
