SUBJECT:- CHARGING OF INTEREST FOR DELAYED APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF LICENSE UNDER THE HARYANA DEVELOPMENT AND REGULATIONS OF URBAN AREAS ACT, 1975.

In exercise of powers contained under Section 3, 9A & 13 of the Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to issue the following policy instructions on the subject mentioned above.

2. The licenses granted under the provision of Section 3 of the Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975 are renewed under the provisions of Rule 14 of the Rules, 1976. The licensee is required to apply to the Director for renewal of license in form LC-VI atleast thirty days before the expiry of license.

3. In case of delay/default in applying for renewal of license within the time period prescribed under the Rules 1976, an interest of 18% (simple) shall be levied for the delayed period. These instructions shall be followed in letter & spirit in all cases that are either pending for renewal as on date or such applications that are received in this regard in the future. Any amount already recovered in this regard shall be considered as final and shall not be subject to review.

4. These instructions shall come into effect immediately. However, appropriate amendment in Rules 1976 be also incorporated.
