Notification

No. C-620/STP(E&V)/2013/2535.- The Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, while disposing off CWP No. 4559 of 2007 has directed vide its orders dated 9th July, 2013 to appoint a Senior Government Officer in the Department as Nodal Officer to check the unauthorized constructions in the restricted belt of Schedule Roads and to take action against them. In compliance of the aforesaid orders, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to appoint Senior Town Planner (Enforcement & Vigilance), Haryana as Noda Officer and Senior Town Planners of the Circles in the Department of Town & Country Planning as Sub Nodal Officers for the aforesaid purpose.

2. Further the Governor of Haryana constitutes a Sub-Committee of the following officers at District level:-

(i) Senior Town Planner of concerned Circle	Chairman-cum-Sub Nodal Officer
(ii) District Town Planner concerned	Member Secretary
(iii) Executive Engineer, PWD (B&R) of concerned area	Member

3. Functions of Nodal Officer and Sub-Committee:-

- (i) The Sub-Committee shall monitor all instances of unauthorized constructions in restricted belt of Scheduled Roads and shall take action taken against them.
- (ii) The Sub-Committee shall hold meeting on quarterly basis. Sub-Nodal Officer-cum-Chairman shall submit a certificate to the Nodal Officer to the effect that no new construction has come up along Scheduled Roads in the area under its jurisdiction and in case any construction has come up, the action has been taken against such construction as per law.
- (iii) The Nodal Officer after assessing the information/certificate supplied by Sub Nodal Officers & after having random visits, shall submit quarterly report to the Director General, Town & Country Planning, Haryana.
